- 67 <u>Waiting Restrictions and Parking Places TRO ENV ID 5906</u> Revocation of No Waiting at Any Time on specified lengths of Cavell Way: Revocation of Disabled Badge Holders at Any time on a specified length of Cavell Way.

The proposed change was stated to be because the specified area was privately owned land and not within the jurisdiction of Devon County Council who could therefore not enforce parking restrictions.

On the proposition of Cllr Leech, seconded Cllr Yelland, it was **RESOLVED** to comment that the description of the site was not clear and whilst the Committee understood the reasons for the proposed change, unrestricted parking could create issues for those attending the hospital.

68 Planning Applications

Cllr Leech gave a brief overview of the role of the Plymouth and South West Devon Joint Local Plan (JLP), National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) and Neighbourhood plans.

1382/24/TPO T1: Western Red Cedar - Reduce overall height of tree by up to 7 metres creating a natural & balanced shaped upper crown, tree is situated on a risen lose bank made up of shillet stone close to the highway, reduce trees sail to reduce the risk of tree failure, T2: Small Beech - Reduce overextended limbs by up to 0.75metres on all sides of tree to shape canopy to allow more light into the beds, T3: Silver birch - Reduce height by up to 2 metres sympathetically reduce long branches by 1 metre on all sides, lateral reduction by 0.75 metres on all sides, to create a balanced natural form & T4: Horse chestnut – Reduce SW side of the tree over hanging the highway by up to 2 meters Balance crown with the rest of the tree to leave a natural looking form. - Highways had indicated they wished to comment, but the comment was not available on the planning portal
- There was no indication of the gate action sliding, swinging or direction of travel and the potential impact on pedestrians and other road users could not be ascertained
- Depending on gate action, traffic holdups could be caused by opening/closing
- Potential for creation of issues for those parking on the opposite side of the road
