The Clerk advised of a potential increase in WDBC dog waste collection fees. Clerk to establish the impact of any agreed increase.

Correspondence originally received in early 2024 from a member of the public in relation to the Public Bridleway adjacent to All Saints Church was further considered. Ownership of the land had been unable to be established although an old plan showed it had been part of Glebelands. It had been previously confirmed that it was not owned by, or the responsibility of the Town Council. Clerk to establish if any further progress had been made or responses to the communication received.
