The Cold Days, Warm Libraries campaign is back to warm up communities this winter. With the cost-of-living crisis continuing and a challenging winter ahead, we're reminding communities that libraries are warm, welcoming spaces with plenty going on beyond borrowing books. The campaign launched in October



and runs until March 2025. Offering warm spaces, free Wi-Fi, computer access, friendly faces and somewhere to chat and connect with others - plus lots of fun activities for all ages.

Town Centre Business Grant Initiative - This grant will enable businesses to apply for funding to spruce up their shop fronts which will improve the overall look of the town centre.
